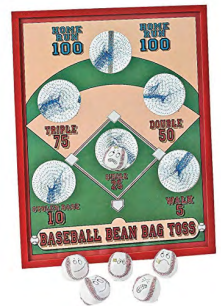

Well guys, we are about 30 days away from starting the 2020 Pool League Play. I have contacted most of you and we are finalizing the players. We could definitely use more subs this year. THE IMPORTANCE OF HARMONY WITH CONTRAST

We recently took a Friendship Tour in Morocco with a small group of 20 Floridians through FGCU. It is my belief that “Peace on Earth” will never be accomplished by world leaders, but by ordinary people having open, accepting minds. I was able to talk with Muslims from Morocco, Algeria, and Iraq—and found those I spoke with sincerely friendly, caring, and helpful.

Beauty and preserving ancient crafts are very important to Morocco. Seeing sites thousands of years old, alongside 20th century buildings, both having individual hand-laid tiles in various patterns and intricate cedar carvings, was a real treat for me the designer. Their abundant, beautiful public gardens were also such a joy to me.

Since their climate is much like ours in Florida, the trees, shrubs, and flowers were all very well known to our group. I did NOT see any of our lovely Royal Poinciana Trees, possibly because they get so enormously wide. But Blue Jacaranda, Olive Trees (200 varieties!), Oleaners, Hibiscus and most of the plants and trees growing down here were also growing there. Prickly Pear cactus is commonly used in the drier regions for fencing, and like us, they use the flesh for making a candy, and for medicinal uses, as well as Aloe plants.

But, as in our own landscapes and gardens, what made the gardens beautiful was not the various plants so much as the good design of the plants’ layout or arrangement, allowing Harmony with Contrast, something we humans are still working on. May you have that wonderful harmony in your lives this season and always, and may you live in Peace!
