#### District 7 FMO Meeting - February 14, 2020 Legacy Moss Landing, LaBelle

FMO President Jerry Durham was the featured guest speaker. He spoke on the progress made in Tallahassee and shared with us the comments heard from Legislators on the impact of all the calls and letters that FMO members directed to Tallahassee. They got the message that we were not happy with them. Senator Hooper, the sponsor of SB818 definitely got the message. Our Legislative Counsel in Tallahassee, Nancy Black Stewart, set up a meeting with 13 legislators and a private meeting with FMO Board members and Senator Hooper to iron out differences in the bill. It was a successful meeting because they agreed for sellers to pass their prospectus on to buyers among other parts of the bill we wanted changed or omitted. Three bills were involved in these changes: SB818, SB998 and HB1339, all had to be rewritten so they matched up to the provisions we were pushing to have included.

After the last session FMHA (park owners association) and FMO realized they had to negotiate and agree amongst themselves to get bills passed more quickly into law in the future.

President Durham shared the plans of FMO for adding webinars to educate residents. FMO is also looking for more committee members on both Membership and Education State Committees.

He reminded us that there is strength in numbers. At the present time FMO has about 15000 members statewide. At one time we were 100,000 strong and had much more influence with legislators in Tallahassee. Raising membership numbers will make our voices much louder in Tallahassee.

The need for the FMO to become more politically active was discussed. Setting up a Voter Registration drive was mentioned.

Affordable housing is a problem that can be addressed by the FMO. Manufactured housing could be part of the solution for many residents of Florida looking for a decent place to live.

We were reminded of the FMO membership contest that is now in place. Each new member enrolled and the sponsor get a chance at winning a Golf Cart, cruise, a \$1000 or a monthly \$100 winning for the highest number of new members for a given month.

The next meeting will be at Southern Pines in Bonita Springs on Friday, March 13th at 1pm. The speaker will be from the Agency of Aging.


